In case of storm and flood disaster (storm, flood, and sediment related disaster)

## Attention to Public Information

Types of Public announcements	Situations when public announcements will be made	Procedures to take
Information on the opening of voluntary evacuation site	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Situations concerning storms, floods, or landslides due to natural conditions, such as a typhoon.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pay attention to weather information. If you think it will become dangerous, voluntarily go to the temporary evacuation site beforehand.</li> </ul>
Commencement of evacuation procedures for the elderly and others requiring assistance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Situations linked to high possibilities of human injury or loss of life due to the occurrences of storms, floods, and landslides.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Those who need time to evacuate, such as senior citizens, handicapped citizens, and those who have children should start evacuation.</li> <li>Other citizens should pay attention to the weather and for prepare for evacuation. If you think it will become dangerous, please evacuate beforehand.</li> </ul>
Instructions for Evacuation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Situations linked to the higher probability of human injury or loss of life.</li> <li>When a landslide warning is made.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Start evacuating immediately.</li> <li>In case it is dangerous outside, immediately evacuate to a safe place.</li> </ul>
Urgent safety and Security	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A Situation where a disaster is about to happen.</li> <li>A life threatening situation has already occurred and evacuation is extremely difficult.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Evacuate immediately to a secure location.</li> </ul>

The situations noted in the above are guidelines for when you should undertake an evacuation. Even when conditions do not meet the notes above, there are times when announcements are given, so please be mindful of any public official information.

※ When you evacuate, bring an emergency bag with you (for example: food, drinking water, your medicine, etc.)
