Pancake Breakfast

In Canada, it is often that at welcome parties for schools and corporates, or celebrative events like Canada Day to have pancake breakfast for people to eat and mix and mingle with each other. Usually, it is taking place in a big space or picnic areas in a park.

Not just salmon, you can also find other seafood dishes in the food trucks and vendors.



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
